

Beginning the evening of Saturday, October 4 and continuing into the early morning of Sunday, October 5, the old Vanier Parkway Bridge was removed to make way for a new bridge. A crew of 100 installed the new 1,400 tonne bridge, which is approximately 56m in length, using Rapid Lift Replacement technology.

Part of the Highway 417 Expansion project which is part of the Confederation Line construction activity, the new Vanier Parkway Bridge is the 7th rapid lift replacement project in the Ottawa area.

We collected thousands of still photos from the installation and created a one minute time-lapse video to give you a sense of how it all came together.
